



ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS OF MENASHA UTILITIES

On April 28, 2017 Menasha Utilities filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) to adjust electric rates. The PSC required Menasha to file an electric rate adjustment by April 30, 2017. The last electric rate adjustment was effective in November 2013.

The utility is requesting no overall change in its total operating revenue. However, Menasha is requesting to update its individual rate schedules to be more reflective of costs to serve each rate class. The final impact of the rate adjustment upon individual customers will not be definitely known until the PSC issues an order; however, under the proposed rate update, the typical residential customer's monthly bill would increase from \$75.17 per month to \$76.75 per month based on average monthly usage of 609 kWhs. This is an increase of \$1.58 or 2.1%.

The PSC will conduct a public hearing at locations in Menasha and Madison on November 30, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. A notice of the hearing will be published with the exact location for the hearing.
